SERVICES FOR PATIENTS

WOMEN, INFANTS & CHILDREN (WIC) PROGRAM - EXT. 148

Eligibility: Low income pregnant, postpartum or breast-feeding women and children up to 5 years of age

who reside in Jackson County

<u>Services:</u> * Food coupons for nutritious foods

- * Nutrition education and counseling
- * Health and parenting education
- * Assessment and monitoring of height, weight, hemoglobin, and blood lead
- * Developmental screening
- * Fluoride application for children under 3 years of age
- * Breastfeeding support, peer counseling and free breast pumps for WIC clients
- * Referrals, advocacy and monitoring of appropriate use of health and community services
- Education on family planning, pregnancy, infant care and parenting
- * Referrals for medical assistance for immediate prenatal care

SEXUAL HEALTH PROGRAM – EXT. 150

Eligibility: Anyone who suspects they have a sexually transmitted disease (STD)

Counseling, testing and treatment for HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia and Hepatitis C, if at Services:

risk; urine based and extragenital testing is available

Low cost and by appointment

Free condoms

Partner contact and follow-up to encourage testing and treatment

TUBERCULOSIS CONTROL - EXT. 151

Eligibility: Any Jackson County resident with latent or active tuberculosis

TB skin tests at low cost Services:

Free follow-up tests as needed (i.e., chest x-ray, sputum culture) for uninsured

Free medications for treatment of active or latent TB, as payer of last resort

Nurse to manage compliance with drug therapy

IMMUNIZATIONS - EXT. 119

Anyone needing immunizations Eligibility:

Recommended childhood vaccines at low cost (medical card accepted) Services:

Computerized immunization records linked to other health departments statewide

All recommended adult vaccines available (costs vary)

No appointment necessary - walk-in clinics Monday - Thursday, 8:30 - 4:30

Accepting most insurances and Medicaid

HIV SERVICES – EXT. 150 FOR TESTING INFORMATION; EXT. 155 FOR OTHER SERVICES

Eligibility: Anyone who believes they are at risk for HIV

Services: Free HIV and Hepatitis C Rapid Testing

> Case management Support groups

Financial assistance for health care, transportation, housing and other needs

Referral to primary care

Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Services available

Linkage to Care, Partner Notification, Diagnosis and Reporting assistance
