ONE COVID-19 RELATED DEATH REPORTED IN JACKSON COUNTY

Jackson County Health Department sadly reports the death of a female in her nineties, who was previously confirmed to have COVID-19. Her death is the nineteenth related to the disease in Jackson County.

No new cases of COVID-19 were reported in Jackson County over the past 24 hours. To date, there have been 323 confirmed cases in Jackson County. Two more individuals were released from isolation in accordance with CDC guidelines, bringing the total released to 289 individuals. Fifteen active cases are currently being managed.

If you have a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle aches, loss of taste or smell, nausea or diarrhea, call your health care provider for further guidance. Three providers are conducting COVID-19 testing of eligible individuals in Jackson County: Southern Illinois Healthcare (SIH) – Call 1-844-988-7800; Shawnee Health Service – Call 618-519-9200; and SIU Center for Family Medicine – Call 618-536-6621.

Also, the State of Illinois has established a temporary testing site at the SIU-C Recreation Center, north side parking lot. The site is open daily through Sunday, June 28, from 9am-5pm. Testing is open to all Illinois residents; participants do not need to be symptomatic or have a known exposure. There is no cost to be tested; participants should bring their insurance card if they have one, but no one will be turned away for lack of insurance. Participants must provide phone number and current address to ensure results can be received. The site should be entered on S. Marion St., accessed via E. Mill St. Follow signage.
