NO NEW COVID-19 CASES REPORTED IN JACKSON COUNTY

No new cases of COVID-19 in were reported to Jackson County Health Department over the past 24 hours. To date, there have been 330 confirmed cases in the county, including 19 related deaths. 296 individuals have been released from isolation in accordance with CDC guidelines. Fifteen active cases are currently being managed.

Illinois Department of Public Health reports that the preliminary seven-day statewide positivity for cases as a percent of total tests is 2.6% from June 24 –June 30.
